Since its opening in 2001, the Kenan Chapel has become an important part of Landfall as well as the larger Wilmington community. Hundreds of weddings, baptisms, memorial services, and other ceremonies have been hosted at the Chapel by Landfall residents and other local families.

The Chapel has sponsored 22 seasons of Sunday afternoon concerts, presented by talented young musicians, the majority are North Carolina residents or students at schools and universities within the state. The concerts are free and open to the public.

Our interfaith Chapel is a charitable 501 (c) (3) trust organization, so all donations are tax-deductible. In addition to supporting the free concerts, donations and proceeds from the festival contribute to Chapel maintenance and are shared with the Great Oaks Club, providing support for landscape and wildlife environment projects.

Our 22nd annual major fund-raising event on October 19th is the Kenan Chapel Fall Festival, which is one of the few community-wide events in Landfall that attracts residents of all ages. We are expanding its activities again this year to attract even more attendees and continuing with the Halloween theme with costumes and events. In years past, attendance exceeded one thousand residents. All Festival sponsors and silent auction donors receive recognition both at the event and in Landfall publications.
